The 2023 Synod Assembly adopted a new bylaw for congregations to elect additional lay voting members beyond the first two from a congregation, including youth, young adults, persons of color, or those whose primary language is other than English. The additional Lay Voting Members may register at a discounted rate of \$50/each for the early-bird registration or \$75/each for the standard rate, as long as the first two Lay Voting Members elected by the congregation have registered.

### History Corner


#### Do You Like Old Cookbooks? -
